

In this first newsletter of the season, I provide you two reports. The first is this summary of the last Fiscal Year (FY22 - Oct 1, 2021 thru Sep 30, 2022). Overall, we did quite well in balancing our finances. However, if you discount the rally income fees (I'll explain below), our expenses are slightly increasing. We need to start thinking about maintaining a higher balance to ensure we are able to cover our costs.

This year, again, we were quite fortunate in being able to donate to the Shriners Children's Hospital. Thank you all for your contributions and your kindness. We also gained six new members throughout the (fiscal) year, as you can see. While it may appear that we pulled in a substantial amount in Rally Fees, some of those were from the September rally (Lively Lady) and the rest was for the October rally, which is covered in the next report. The other expenses were for badges for new members, new bank checks, and postage. Our recurring costs include the Quicken subscription, website hosting through FMCA and the annual National Director stipend.



Part of the Treasurer's task is to file with the IRS annually after each fiscal year. This task was completed on 8 Feb.

OHIO NOMADS TREASURER HALF-YEAR REPORT

The second financial report spans the 6-month period from Oct 1, 2022 through 31 March, 2023. Thank you to all members for making their annual dues payment. A few of you also sent donations for the Shriners, which will be presented to them later this year. In October we had a few more dollars of income for the Darke County Rally, which we immediately spent for campground fees, food and rally supplies, as well as some refunds due to members. Our last expense is our website hosting service from FMCA, which I pay ahead for the entire year to reduce time and effort.






